Subject: Modification of User Waypoints.

The Chelton FlightLogic EFIS allows the pilot to create user waypoints using three different methods:

1. Fly over designate
2. Latitude/longitude
3. Radial/distance from any airport, Nav aid, or fix

Once created, these waypoints can be edited, renamed, enabled for VFR approaches, etc.

Like any other waypoint, they can also be included in stored flight plans.

Be advised that, if a user waypoint is edited AFTER it has been included in a flight plan, the edits will not be applied to that waypoint in any flight plan in which it was included.

When changes are made to a user waypoint and those changes are desired in existing flight plans that use the waypoint, it must be deleted and replaced following these steps:

1. **Edit** the user waypoint
2. **Open** a flight plan that uses the user waypoint
3. **Delete** the existing user waypoint from the flight plan
4. **Add** the edited user waypoint back into the flight
5. **Save** and Exit
6. **Reload** the flight plan if it was in use.

This will be addressed in Pilot's Guide Version G.
